



ICE-WORLD RECOMMENDATIONS FOR COVID-19 PROOF ICE RINK LAYOUTS






600M² (20X30M) WITH ICEBYK PARKOUR



- SKATING LANE ZONE 1 (E.G. ADULTS) 72X3M (216M²) CAPACITY 70 SKATERS
- 2 SAFE DISTANCE LANE 54X1,5M (81M²) NO SKATING
- 3 SKATING LANE ZONE 2 (E.G. KIDS) 32X4M (128M²) CAPACITY 40 SKATERS
- REST ZONE WITH BENCHES AND WALLS 5X3M (15M²) CAPACITY 4 SKATERS ON 2 BENCHES (2 PER BENCH)
- ICEBYK TRACK 8X20M (160M²)
 CAPACITY 12 ICEBYKERS

TOTAL CAPACITY 114 SKATERS AND 12 ICEBYKERS



300M² (15X20M)




- SKATING LANE ZONE 1 (E.G. ADULTS) 58X3M (174M²) CAPACITY 50 SKATERS
- 2 SAFE DISTANCE LANE 40X1,5M (60M²)
 NO SKATING
- 3 SKATING LANE ZONE 2 (E.G. KIDS) 19X3M (57M²) CAPACITY 15 SKATERS
- 4 CENTRE PIECE (9M²)
 NO SKATING

TOTAL CAPACITY 65 SKATERS

Remarks for all above layouts

- For the capacity it is assumed that 1-3 people skate next to each other in one lane (3-4m wide) with a distance of 1,5m-2m behind the next group. Example: 88m lane length / 2m distance = 44 groups behind each other x 2 skaters per group next to each other = 88 skaters in total. Allowing some extra space, the maximum capacity calculated is 80 skaters.
- The skating zones can be divided according to local skating culture. Some countries with many inexperienced skaters would want them to skate on the outer lane as inexperienced skaters often want to be close to the handrail. In other countries the outer lane might be more suitable for faster skaters as they would want wider corners than e.g. kids with skating aids. It also depends on the size of a given group at a giving time as the outer zone can accommodate more people.
- Not more than 4 skaters in a group or family together without keeping distance.
- The total rink capacity should never exceed 1 skater per 4m² ice surface. Within a zone on the rink it can be higher as the safe distance lane creates some extra space.
